You are in custody of the Court by reason of your felony/misdemeanor conviction. Your rights as a citizen are restricted until your probation is terminated. As a probationer, you can be arrested without warrant by any Probation Officer or by any other police authority upon written order of your Probation Officer.

IT IS THE ORDER OF THE COURT THAT YOU SHALL COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS OF PROBATION:

- Report to your probation officer as directed. Complete the written report form accurately and completely with every office visit.

- Upon reporting to the Probation Dept. and when in Court you shall conduct yourself in an orderly manner, otherwise you may be charged with disorderly conduct.
- Pay all restitution, probation supervision fees, court costs, fines, drug testing fees (if applicable) and other Court approved fees in regular monthly installments unless otherwise ordered by the court. Two consecutive lapses in monthly payments will result in notification of the court. All costs with the exception of supervision fees which are to be paid on a per month basis are to be paid in full 60 days prior to the expiration of your probation.
- Submit as directed to observed drug or alcohol testing. You must provide a sufficient, acceptable sample for the test if the test being administered is a urinalysis. The only controlled substances you are permitted to have or to use are those properly prescribed by your doctor and you must provide proof of prescription upon request. Additionally, you cannot possess any instrument, device or other objects used to administer drugs. Also, you are not to eat poppy seeds.
- Submit as directed to evaluation and/or treatment for substance abuse, mental health, or other problems. You shall take medication as prescribed by you doctor and shall authorize release of information to the Probation Department.
- You shall follow all rules and regulations of treatment facilities or programs of any type in which you are placed or ordered to attend while under the jurisdiction of the Medina County Adult Probation Department. If you are convicted of either a past or present alcohol related offense, you are prohibited from consuming alcoholic beverages while on probation.
- Inform your probation officer immediately of any changes in your residence, employment, or source of income within 48 hours.
- You are prohibited from promoting any illegal paraphernalia such as drugs, weapons, etc. on any website that you are associated with.
- Do not associate with persons having known criminal felony records (including convicted co-defendants in your case) without permission from the court or your probation officer.
- Do not purchase, use, possess, have access to, or carry a firearm, deadly weapon or dangerous ordnance. (Prohibited: bb guns, paint ball guns, knives (only eating utensils permitted), bow-n-arrow/cross bow, etc).
- Do not leave your state of residence without permission from your probation officer. You must obtain written permission prior to leaving the State of Ohio. You will not be permitted to travel the first 60 days of supervision.
- Obey all local, state and federal laws. Report any new arrests or questioning by any law enforcement officer within 48 hours to your probation officer.
- You shall not enter into any agreement to act as an informer or a special agent of a law enforcement agency without the permission of the Court.
- You may not work on any job caring for the elderly, children, or mentally disabled without the permission of the Judge or Probation Department.
- Within 30 days of instruction in these rules, you shall obtain and carry on your person at all times, a valid photo identification issued by the State of Ohio, Federal Government, another State where you reside, or other identification approved by the Probation Department. You shall produce this identification upon request.
- You shall waive your Fourth Amendment rights to search and seizure by your Probation Officer. Any search may include your person, any electronic devices, vehicle, residence as well as any other property or area under your control at any given time and may be conducted either by your Probation Officer and/or any other law enforcement official if directed by your Probation Officer.
- Anyone convicted of a sex-related offense may not view, possess, or be associated with any type of pornographic materials including, but not limited to computer usage.
- These conditions may be modified upon approval of the Court and/or the Probation Department. Offender will be apprised of any changes.
- I agree and understand that if I am arrested in any other state or territory of the United States or any foreign country, my signature as witnessed at the bottom of this form will be deemed to be a waiver of extradition and no other formalities will be required for authorized agents of the state of Ohio to bring about my return to this state.

I hereby acknowledge that I have read (or had read to me) the above conditions of probation and community control. I understand these conditions and have received a copy of them. Until such terms are modified, they shall remain in effect as written above. I further understand that failing to comply with one or more of the above conditions may result in my arrest, a violation hearing, and imposition of jail or prison sentence.
