

ELIGIBILITY CHECKLIST*Check all items that apply in Offense, Victim and Offender sections.***OFFENSE**

	Is not a felony offense of the first, second or third degree (excluding felony three possessions)
	Is not an offense of violence
	Is not a violation of Division (A) (1) or (2) or Section 2903.06 of the Revised Code (Aggravated Vehicular Homicide); Division (A) (a) of Section 2903.08 (Aggravated Vehicular Assault) Division (A) (1) of Section 4511.19 of the Revised Code (DWI) or a municipal ordinance that is substantially similar to that division
	Is not a violation of Section 2925.02 (Corruption); 2925.04 (Manufacturing and Cultivation); 2925.06 (Steroids); 2925.03 (Trafficking F1, F2, F3, F4 offense)
	If charged with a violation of section 2925.24 (Tampering with drugs), the alleged violation did not result in physical harm to any person and the offender has not previously been treated for drug abuse.
	Is not a violation of Section 2925.11 (Possession) of the Revised Code that is a felony of the first or second degree
	Intervention in Lieu of Conviction would not demean the seriousness of the offense
	Intervention in Lieu of Conviction would substantially reduce the likelihood of any future activity

VICTIM

	Was not sixty-five years of age or older, permanently and totally disabled, under thirteen years of age
	Was not a peace officer engaged in the officer's official duties at the time of the alleged offense

OFFENDER

	Has not been previously convicted of or pled guilty to a felony offense of violence
	Is charged with a felony for which the Court, upon conviction, would impose community control sanctions
	Has been assessed by an appropriate agency for the purpose of determining the offender's eligibility for Intervention in Lieu of Conviction and recommends an appropriate intervention plan
	Has drug or alcohol usage or had a mental illness or was a person with intellectual disability, or was a victim of violation ORC 2905.03 (trafficking in persons) and that the mental illness, status as a person with intellectual disability, or fact that the offender was a victim of a violation of section 2905.32 of the ORC was a factor leading to the offender's criminal behavior at the time offense occurred and for which the offender is charge.
	Is willing to comply with all terms and conditions imposed by the court
